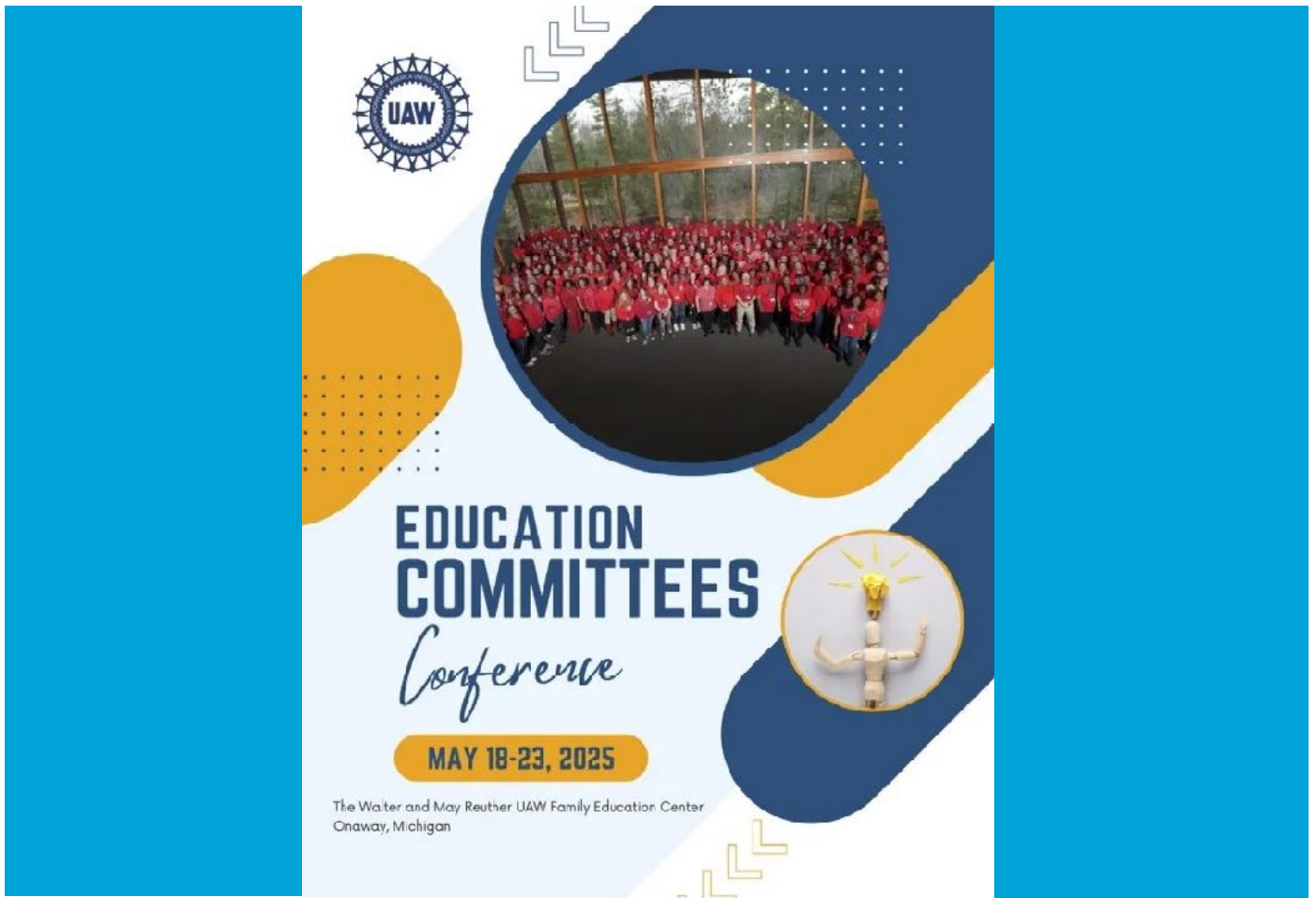

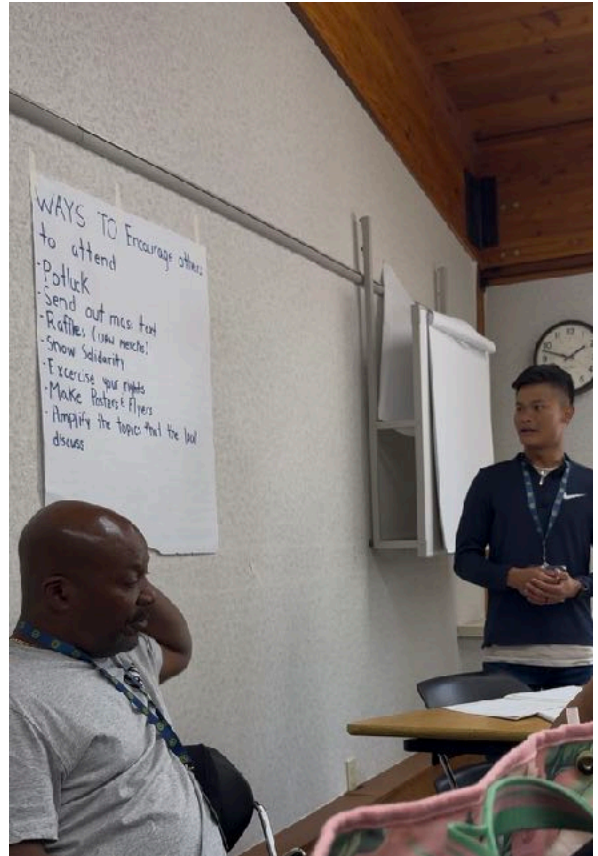

What we Experienced:

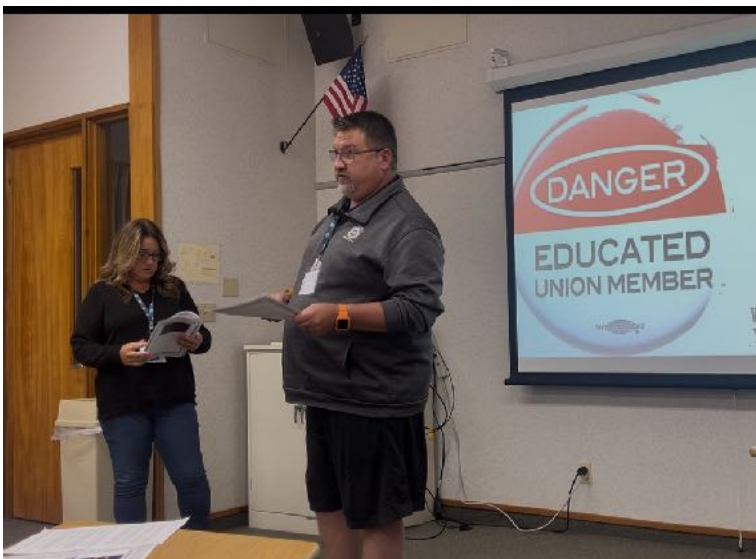
Throughout the week, we immersed ourselves in learning what it truly means to lead educational spaces that are inclusive, engaging, and empowering. The training offered practical tools and insight into

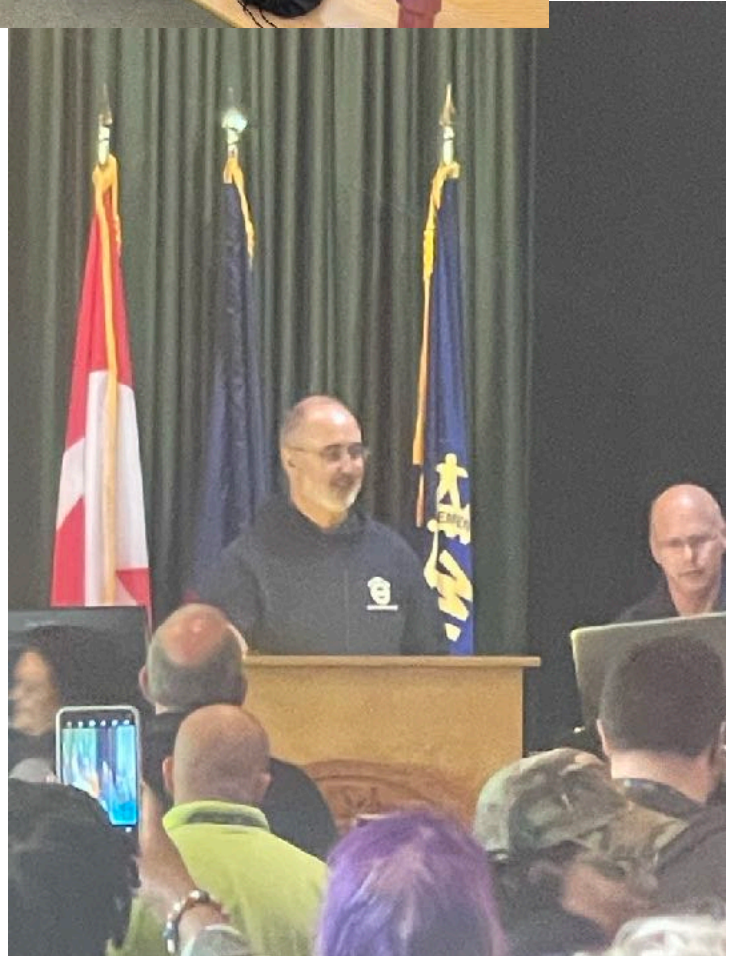
